

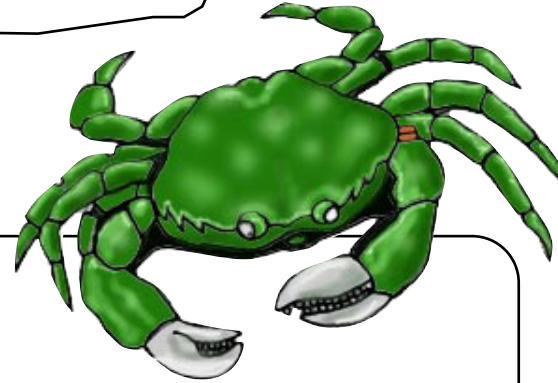

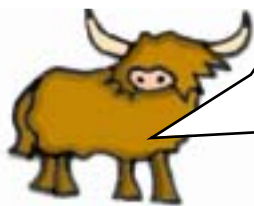
4. Imagine a crab could speak, what sort of a voice would he have? Would it speak like a woman or a man? Would it be old or young, sad or happy?

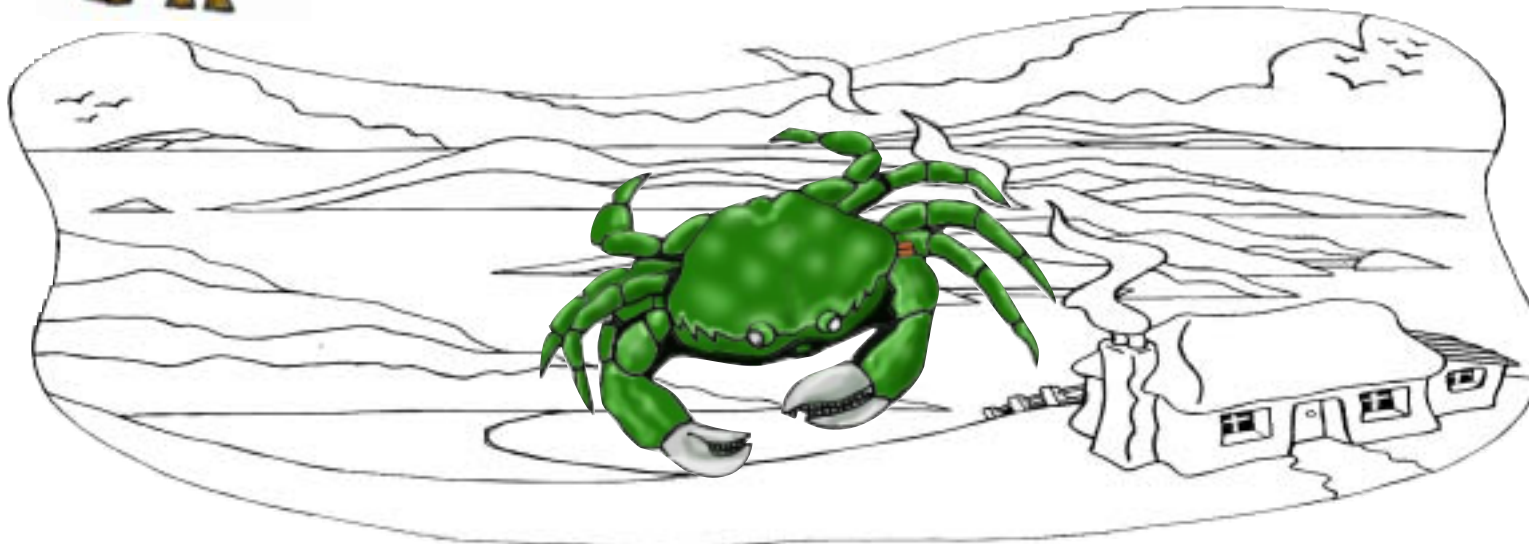
5. Imagine if a crab could dream, what do you think he would dream of?
