1. Write down the first words that come into your head when you hear the word 'seagull', what does the word 'seagull' make you think of?

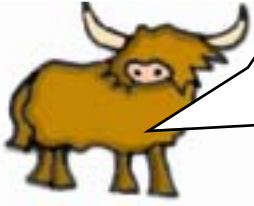
2. Close your eyes and imagine you are a seagull flying in the air, what would it feel like, what would you do, where would you live?

3. Think about when you last saw a seagull, where were you, what did it do?

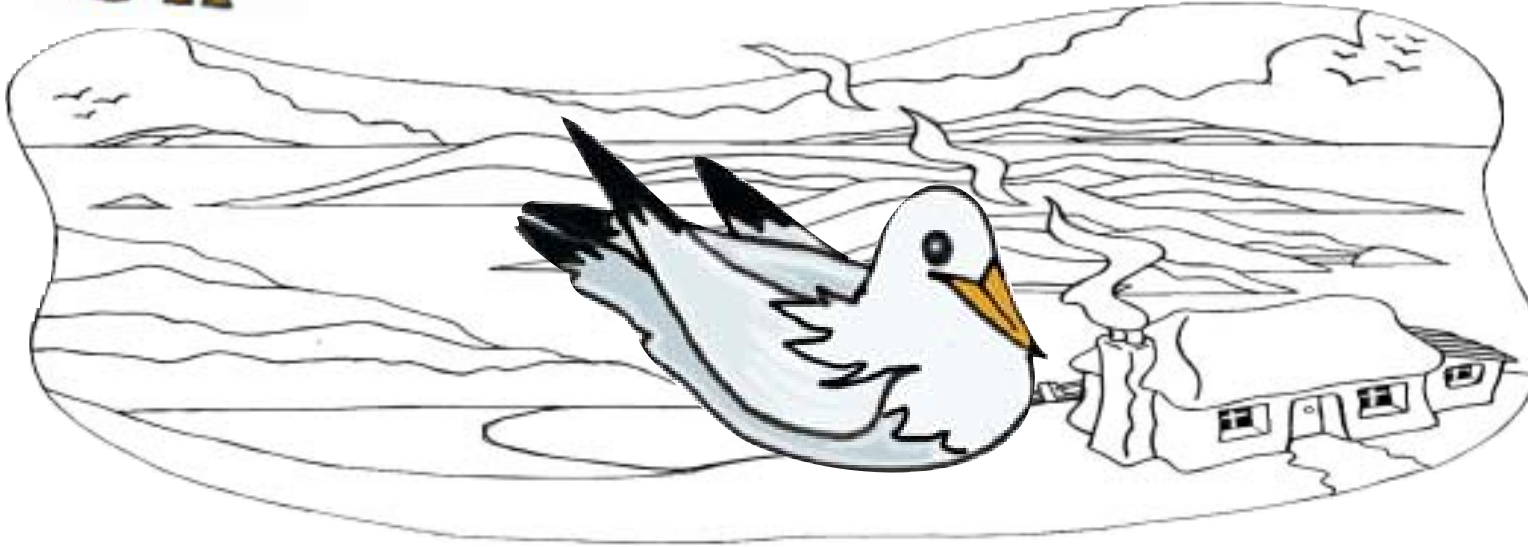
4. Imagine a seagull could speak, what sort of a voice would it have, would it speak like a woman or a man, would it be old or young, sad or happy?
